**WEATHER**-WE CAN NEVER PREDICT THE WEATHER, BUT GENERALLY YOU CAN EXPECT TEMPERATURES 20 TO 25 DEGREES COOLER THAN IN PHOENIX. THE ALTITUDE IS APPROXIMATELY 6,850 FEET. A JACKET OR SWEATER IS NEEDED IN THE SUMMER AND VERY WARM CLOTHING IN THE WINTER.
